

The "Dairy Day at the 'Moo'seum" Cooking Contest Rules & Registration Information

Sponsored by the Hoard Historical Museum

This year's theme: Dessert

<u>Date of the cooking contest:</u> June 11, 2016. All entries must be received by 11:15 a.m. Judging will occur behind closed doors at 11:30 a.m.

Purpose: To feature the incredible variety of goodies that can be produced from dairy products and to showcase the tasty talents of local bakers!

<u>Who can enter:</u> Anyone! There are three categories: Youth (17 and under); Adult (18 and over); and Family/Mixed group (2 or more youth and/or adult(s)). You do not need to live in Jefferson County to enter.

How to enter:

- ➤ Bring your dessert to the Hoard Historical Museum between 10 a.m. and 11:15 a.m. on June 11, 2016.
- The minimum size of an entry is either ½ a cake, pie, loaf or bread, OR a minimum of 5 individual items such as cookies, muffins, etc. You may enter the entire item if you desire.
- Two (2) copies of the recipe form must be submitted with the entry. Staple a recipe card to the forms or write the recipe on the forms. You may type the recipe directly onto the form.
- Entries must contain at least two (2) dairy products. Eggs are not a dairy product.
- Entries must be on/in a disposable container. We cannot guarantee that your dessert will be returned.
- ➤ Judges will use the following criteria: Flavor (smell, taste, flavoring); Inside Characteristics (texture); Overall Appearance (surface appearance, size and color); and Creativity. Judges will also take into consideration the creative use of and number of dairy products in the dessert.
- Each category will be judged separately.
- ➤ Winners will receive ribbons, certificates, and baking-related prizes. Awards will be given prior to the Cow Parade at 1:30 p.m.
- ➤ Once judging is complete, baked goods will be available for public viewing.
- Prizes are awarded at the discretion of the independent judges, who are not museum staff.
- The Hoard Historical Museum assumes no responsibility for loss or damage to entries.
- The Hoard Historical Museum, with permission of the baker, has the right to use the recipe as promotion in print or otherwise and will give credit to the baker.
- > Limit two entries per person/group.
