Adult Show Entries

Adult (18 years and older) artists living, working, or taking classes in Jefferson County cities and rural areas may enter.

Artwork Requirements:

1. Must be original and completed in the last 2 years.
2. Must *not* have been exhibited before in an earlier Mary Hoard Art Show.
3. Must be the original production of the artist entering. Entries made with the use of commercial kits, patterns or components, copies of published materials, & copies of existing work by another artist will not be accepted.
4. All media but photography will be accepted.
5. Must remain on display until the close of the exhibition, Saturday May 5, at 2:00. No exceptions.
6. Must adhere to the "Rules for Display" listed below.

Rules for Display: work must be delivered framed and ready to install **with 1 entry form taped to the back.**

- All 2-D work must be wired, ready to hang, and capable of supporting its own weight. No exceptions.
- Hanging hardware (eye screws and picture-hanging wire only) must be securely fastened to all 2-D artwork. **Items without hardware or with saw-tooth hangers or other hangers will not be accepted. No exceptions.**
- 2-D work maximum framed size is no larger than 48 X 60 inches with a maximum depth of 3 inches.
- 3-D work must sit level and be no larger than 2 feet x 2 feet x 6 feet tall and no more than 40 lbs. in weight.

Entry Categories

<u>Non-Professional Level</u>	<u>Professional ** Level</u>
2-D, 3-D, and Local Significance*	2-D, 3-D, and Local Significance*

*Entries in the **Local Significance** category must depict specific persons, objects, events, places, buildings, or landscapes within Jefferson County.

**An artist is a professional if she/he has 2 or more years of college-level art training.

Fee: \$15 per individual artist. (Entry fees pay for judges and fund awards.)

Entry Limit: 2 entries may be submitted; a maximum of 3 entries, if one of the three is a Local Significance entry. Jewelry sets constitute one entry.

Registration Dates

Tuesday, April 10, 3-5 p.m.; Wednesday, April 11, 3-5 p.m.; Thursday, April 12, 3 -5 p.m.;

Saturday, April 14, 10 a.m.-4 p.m.

Cash prizes and ribbons will be awarded for first, second, and third place in each category.

Prizes are awarded at the discretion of the judges.

All entries must be removed from the museum on Tuesday, May 8, between 8:00-10:00 am and 3:00-4:00 p.m. Art can also be picked up after 2p.m. on Saturday, May 5.

Checks for sold artwork will be mailed to the artists after Wednesday, May 9.
