

## Dairy Day at the MOOseum

### Grilled Cheese Cooking Contest Rules & Registration Information

**Date of the cooking contest:**

June 2, 2018. Cooking begins at 12:30 p.m.; all entries must be brought to the judging table by 1 p.m.

**Who can enter:** Youth (12-17) and Adults (18+). Youth must have a parent/guardian present while grilling the sandwich. You do not need to live in Jefferson County to enter.

**Cost:** It is \$10 per participant to enter the contest; youth entries are free.

**Categories:** There are two categories of sandwich: Classic (bread & cheese) and Open (bread, cheese, and other ingredients). Both may include butter (with or without additional flavors) on the exterior of the sandwich. Participants may enter 1 sandwich in one or both categories.

**How to participate:**

- **Please pre-register for the contest by Friday, June 1<sup>st</sup>. To register, email [info@hoardmuseum.org](mailto:info@hoardmuseum.org); call 920-563-7769 or stop by the museum. We will need your name and which category you plan to enter.**
- **Fill out both entry forms and bring both with you on Saturday, June 2<sup>nd</sup>. For adults, also bring the \$10 registration fee.**
- The Hoard Museum will provide table space for preparation as well as tabletop non-stick electric griddles for sandwich grilling; however, you may bring your own griddle as long as it is a tabletop non-stick electric griddle. Sandwich presses and sandwich grills are not allowed.
- The Museum will also provide a disposable apron and disposable gloves to each participant.
- You are responsible for all your sandwich ingredients, including bread, cheese, butter, additional ingredients, etc. Please feel free to bring ingredients for more than one sandwich; however, you are only allowed to enter one sandwich per category. Note: Any additional cooked ingredients such as bacon, onions, etc., must be pre-cooked offsite prior to the grilling.
- You are also responsible for bringing your own spatula and other potential grill items such as hotpads.
- Beginning at 12:30 p.m., you may start to construct and grill your sandwich in the Jones Family Gallery.
- The Hoard Museum will provide a plate for your sandwich once it has been grilled.
- Judges will use the following criteria: Flavor (smell, taste); Inside Characteristics (texture); Overall Appearance (surface appearance, size and color); and Creativity. Judges will also take into consideration the creative use of and amount of cheese in the sandwich.
- Each category will be judged separately.
- Winners will receive prizes and ribbons. Awards will be given prior to the Cow Parade at 1:30 p.m.
- Prizes are awarded at the discretion of the independent judges, who are not museum staff.
- The Hoard Historical Museum assumes no responsibility for loss or damage to entries.
