Kindergarten—5th grade entry form & guidelines

School entries are reserved for K — 8 students who attend public, private, or home schools within the Fort Atkinson School District. Each artist may submit one entry on any subject. There is no entry fee.

Artwork Requirements: entries not following these criteria can not be accepted.

1. Artwork must be original* and completed in the last two years.
2. Artwork must *not* have been exhibited before in an earlier Mary Hoard Art Show.
3. All 2-D entries must be matted with matboard or construction paper, but not framed. Work must be no larger than 18 by 24 inches, **including the matboard.**
4. Digitally produced artwork will be entered in the 2-D category.
5. Only 2-D work is accepted for grades K-5.

*Entries made with the use of commercial kits, patterns or components, copies of published materials, & copies of published materials or copyrighted images including licensed cartoon characters, will *not* be accepted.

Instructions and Important Dates

- Fill out 2 entry blanks for your artwork and bring both forms with your art to the museum. Please do not cut the forms.
- Bring your artwork to the Hoard Museum on the following dates and times:

Thursday, March 10 (<u>final drop off date for teachers</u>)	3:00 - 5:00
Saturday, March 12	10:00 - 4:00

Entries will not be accepted after 4:00 p.m. on Saturday, March 12.
