

62nd Annual Mary Hoard Art Show, Part 2

High School Entries

Students in grades 9 through 12, who reside in or are enrolled in the Fort Atkinson School District, are eligible to enter this show. This includes those who attend private schools or home schools. Each student may submit one entry. There is no entry fee.

Artwork Requirements:

1. must be original* work and completed in the last three years.
2. must *not* have been exhibited in an earlier in-person Mary Hoard Art Show.
3. 2D, 2D digital, & 3D work may be submitted with the exception of photography.
4. must remain on display through the close of the exhibition, Saturday, May 7, at 4:00 p.m.
5. must adhere to the **Rules for Display** listed below.

*Entries made with the use of commercial kits, patterns or components, copies of published materials, or copies of published materials or copyrighted images including licensed cartoon characters, will not be accepted.

Rules for Display:

- 2D & 2D digital work must be framed or matted. Gallery wrap (finished canvas sides) is acceptable.
- 2D & 2D digital work must be ready to hang using securely fasten eye screws and picture-hanging wire.
- 2D & 2D digital works must be no larger than 48 X 60 inches with a maximum depth of 3 inches.
- 3D works must sit level and be no larger than 2 ft. x 2 ft. x 6 ft. tall and 40 lbs. in weight.

Entry Instructions: Fill out both entry blanks for your artwork. PLEASE PRINT NEATLY!
Do not cut the entry blank form.

Bring your artwork to the Hoard Museum on the following dates and times:
