Kindergarten - 5th grade entry form & guidelines

School entries are reserved for K — 8 students who attend public, private, or home schools within the Fort Atkinson School District area. Each artist may submit one entry on any subject. There is no entry fee.

Artwork Requirements: *entries must follow these criteria to be accepted.*

- Artwork must be original and completed in the last year.
- Artwork must *not* have been exhibited before in an earlier Mary Hoard Art Show.
- All 2-D entries must be matted with matboard or construction paper, but not framed.
- Work must weigh less than two pounds and be no larger than 18 by 24 inches, <u>including</u> the matboard.
- Digitally produced artwork will be entered in the 2-D category.
- Only 2-D work is accepted for grades K-5.

Please Note: Entries made with the use of the following WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED:

- commercial kits, patterns or components such as paint-by-number kits
- copies of published materials such as coloring sheets
- copyrighted images including licensed cartoon characters such as Spider Man

Instructions and Important Dates

- Fill out 2 entry blanks for your artwork and bring both forms with your art to the museum.

 Note: Please do not cut the forms. The Museum will cut and adhere the forms to artwork.
- To Enter: Bring your artwork to the Hoard Museum on the following dates and times:

Tuesday, February 27 3:00 - 5:00 Wednesday, February 28 3:00 - 5:00

Thursday, February 29 3:00 - 5:00 (<u>final drop off date for teachers</u>)

Saturday, March 2 10:00 - 4:00 Entries will not be accepted after 4:00 p.m. on Saturday, March 2.


Show opens on Wednesday, March 13 from 5:30 to 7 pm; awards given at 6:30 pm
